



The charts below represent self-reported income, demographic, and household data. Applicants are not required to identify race, gender, or age. A family is considered low income if their annual income is less than 80% of the area median family income (AMFI) of their county as designated by HUD. Household and Applicant Demographics – 48 Counties HAP









Household and Applicant Demographics – City of Houston HAP




Overall LMI vs. Non-LMI

Income Levels for Approved HAP Applicants





Overall LMI vs. Non-LMI


Income Levels for Approved HAP Applicants


