

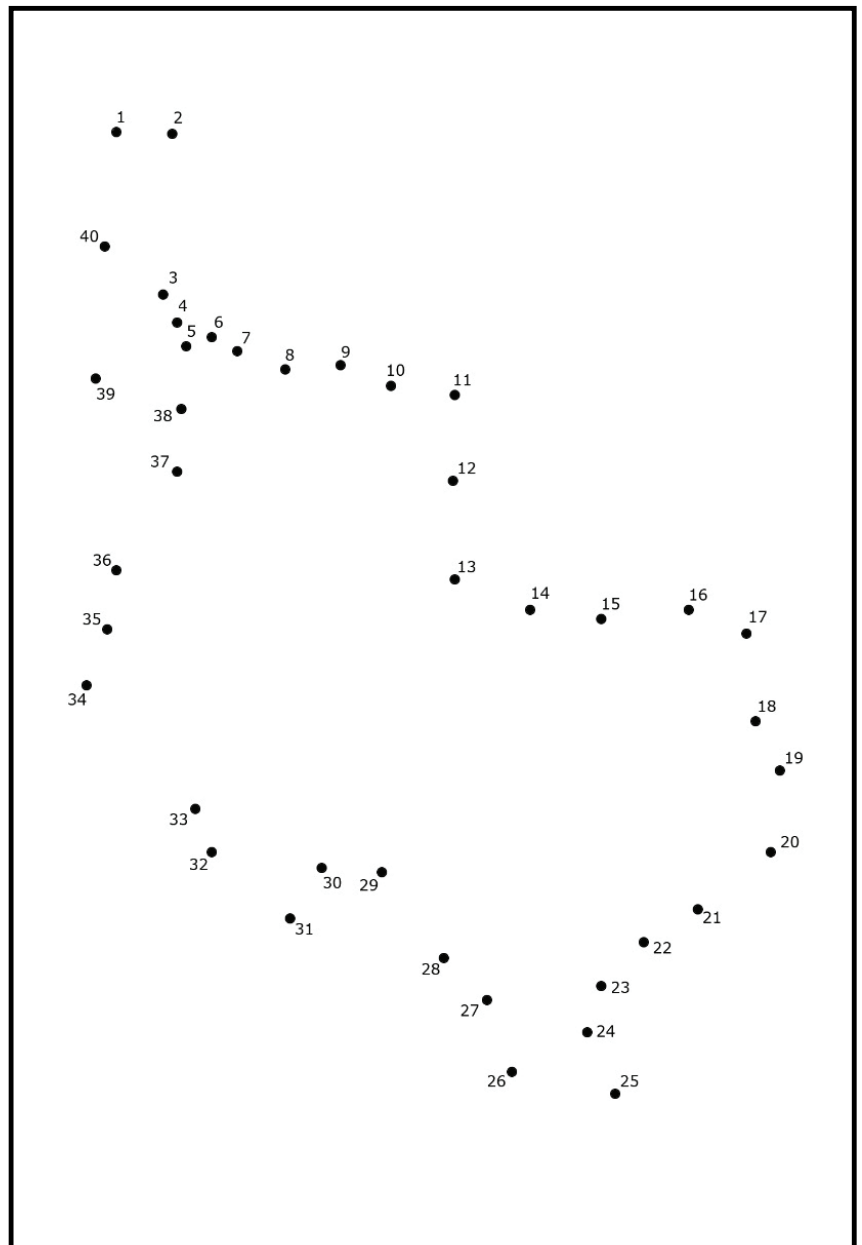

Stovepipe Texas from *Map of Texas in 1836*

Texas hasn't always looked the way it does today. When the Republic of Texas was formed in 1836, Texians (as they were then called) claimed a much larger territory. The top of Texas, which resembled a stovepipe, even reached as far north as present-day Wyoming!

This outline of Texas was created from *Map of Texas in 1836*, a map in the GLO Archives that was created in 1936 to celebrate the **centennial** of Texas independence.
