NOTICE OF SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF THE SCHOOL LAND BOARD

The School Land Board will conduct a special called meeting to be held in person on January 20, 2026, at 2:00 P.M. at the Stephen F. Austin Building, 1700 N. Congress Ave., Room 170, in accordance with the Texas Government Code §551 (Texas Open Meetings Act). Access to the meeting by members of the public will be published in advance in the Texas Register in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act. This webcast option does not allow for two-way communication between members of the public and the Board.
