Cycles 14 and 15 Port Lavaca Causeway Fishing Pier Improvements

- Cycles 14 and 15 CMP 306A funds were combined to reconstruct 100 linear feet of the Port Lavaca Causeway Fishing Pier with marine grade lumber.
- The engineer's final inspection was conducted July 15, 2011 with no deficiencies in construction work identified.
- This concludes the eighth phase of the pier reconstruction, totaling approximately 915 linear feet of the original 2,300 foot pier.
