

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORT LAVACA (THE CITY), CALHOUN COUNTY, TEXAS, AGREEING TO ACCEPT AND TREAT WASTEWATER FROM THE NAUTICAL LANDINGS MARINA SEWAGE PUMP-OUT STATION.

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded funds under the Texas Coastal Management Program (the Program) Contract No. 12-418-000-6478 to construct and install a boat sewage pump-out station in Nautical Landings Marina; and

WHEREAS, the Program requires that the City formally commit to accept sewage collected at the pump-out station and discharge to the City's wastewater treatment facility.
