Major accomplishments:

The City executed a contract with Randall-Porterfield Architects, Inc to develop technical specifications and construction drawings. Technical specifications and construction drawings were submitted to the GLO for approval on December 22, 2015. The City solicited bids for a construction contractor. At the first bid opening on September 3, 2015, only one bid was submitted for review; therefore, a second bid opening was scheduled. A low bidder was recommended by the architect. On October 13, 2015, the City Council approved Charnock and Company as construction contractor. The contract was signed on November 5, 2015.

Task 2: Construction

Provide a brief description of the task.

The City will improve grading and drainage to direct the flow of runoff into the wetlands. Native vegetation will be planted to expand the existing marsh to capture runoff to the south. Two interpretive plazas, an 80-foot decomposed granite/paver walkway, and three covered picnic tables with slabs will be constructed. Interpretive

signage will be installed to educate visitors of aquatic and upland wildlife, seasonal changes in birding, and historical perspectives of the changing waterfront. The City will install temporary CMP signage at the site during construction. The Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (TDLR) must certify the construction as compliant with ADA standards.

Describe major accomplishments for this reporting period (include names of staff working on each task, and dates and locations of events/presentations/meetings.)

Construction began on December 1, 2015. In October 2016 the outline of the plazas and walkways were started. In November 2016 grading and drainage was completed. In March 2017 construction started on the walkways and plazas and the concrete was poured for the walkways and plazas in late April 2017. The pavers were ordered in July 2017 and delivered in mid-August. The City worked with the GLO's Construction Services team to determine the layout and design of the picnic areas and plazas. The pavers were installed in October 2017 and the location of the picnic tables was finalized. The City solicited bids for the picnic shelters and plazas in November 2017 and construction began in December 2017. By January 2018 wetland planting and enhancement was complete. Construction was complete in April 2018 and the TDLR inspection was completed in May 2018. Deficiencies were found but not in areas paid for my CMP.
