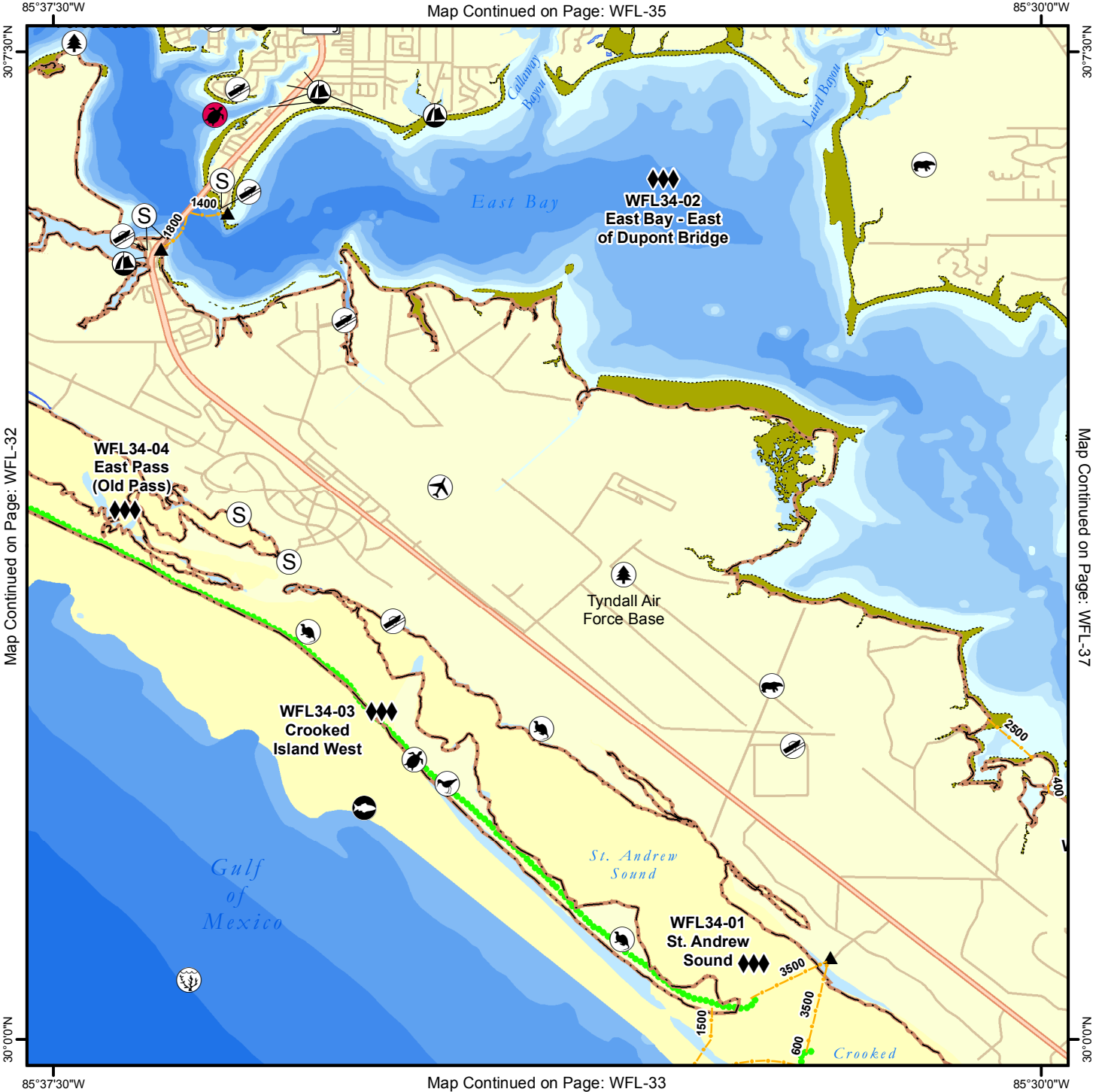


Geographic Response Plan Map: WFL-34
