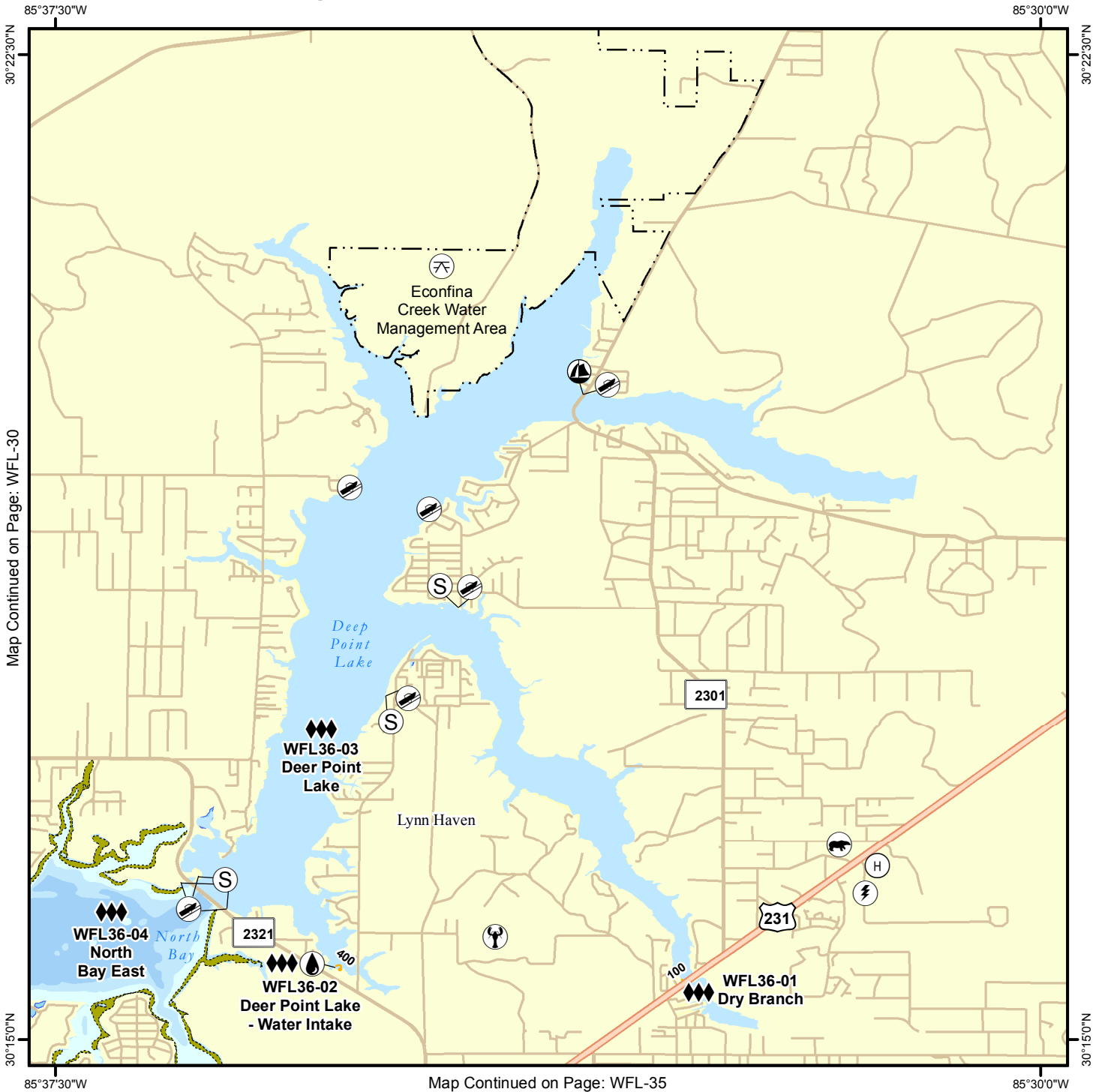


Geographic Response Plan Map: WFL-36
